Information and Eligibility Requirements

Scholarship Eligibility Requirements

- Must have a GPA of 2.5 or greater
- Must be accepted or enrolled full-time at an accredited college or university
- Must be pursuing a degree program in agriculture or an agricultural related program (animal science, food science, agricultural economics/communications/education, etc.)

Academic Documentation

Submit a completed application

- Provide official transcripts
- Provide a recent professional photo (3x3 or larger)

Deadline

Applications and supporting documentation must be postmarked no later than **May 2nd**. Any applicant documentation not postmarked by **May 2nd** will be disqualified.
